Charlotte's Web

This year's whole school performance of Charlotte's Web was a huge success with parents and other members of the community, including students from other schools and embers of a number of retirement homes, attending both the matinee and evening performances.

The performance allowed students to demonstrate their many and varied skills and talents with students taking on starring roles, singing in small groups and individually playing musical instruments. A number of outcomes from the Creative Arts Key Learning Area were addressed in the lead up to and during the Charlotte's Web performance. Students were given opportunities to sing, play and move to a range of music demonstrating an understanding of musical concepts. The students used movement, voice and the elements of drama to sustain dramatic roles and they performed dances from a range of contexts demonstrating movement and expressive qualities.

The whole school performance of Charlotte's Web provided opportunities for 100% of students to contribute either on stage (acting, singing, dancing and playing musical instruments) or back stage (organising and making props and setting up music). All students from kindergarten to year 6 were involved in choreographing and performing dances for the school musical. In addition to singing and dancing students in years 5 and 6 performed by acting and/or narrating various roles.

Staff and parents supported the performance with costuming, prop making, lighting and sound, photography and filming. A fabulous annual community event.
