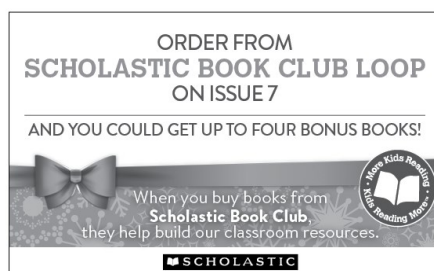
In the Spotlight
